REPORT FROM TRINIDAD AND TOBAGO

The chickenpox cases previously reported are not a threat to the Summit.

No viral or bacterial isolates were identified from stool samples from patients previously reported with diarrhea.

CAREC LABORATORY/ TRINIDAD PUBLIC HEALTH LABORATORY (TPHL)

No unusual pathogens were identified during the reporting period for the Region.

REGIONAL HEALTH SITUATION

Dengue outbreaks are ongoing in some countries in the Southern Cone and Andean Region; Argentina, Brazil, Paraguay and Bolivia.

In Central America and the Caribbean dengue activity continues in some countries but there have been no official reports of outbreaks.

COMMENTS

The Summit ended during the early afternoon of April 19, 2009. This is the final CAREC/PAHO Summit surveillance report.
